1. Open Mac System Preferences





2. Click "Internet Accounts"
3. Next click on "Exchange"




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4. Enter your Name, Email address Example: jmctest@misda.org and click "sign in"

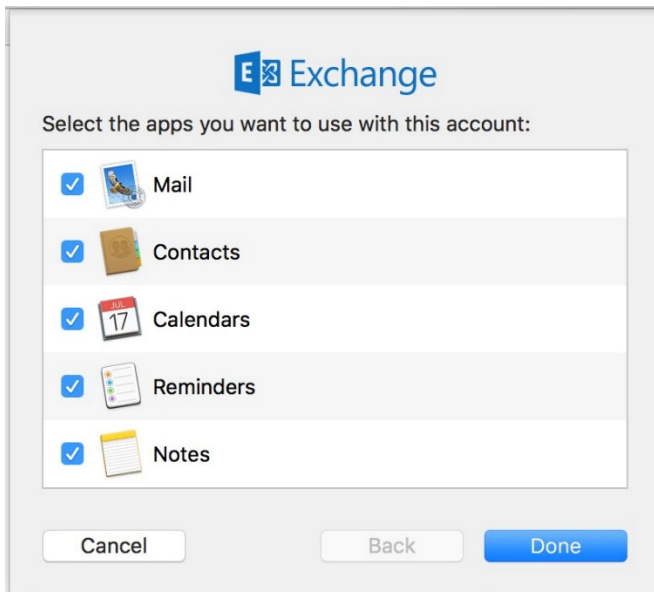
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5. On the next screen click "sign in"
